To whom it may concern:

As a matter of long term policy due to the 2014 recommendation of the United States Animal Health Association, the State Veterinarian of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture (NDA) allows a variance from the requirements of the Animal Importation Regulations Title 23 Chapter 2-005.04A(1)(a) for the import of male cattle which have tested negative for Trichomoniasis by a test or tests, approved by NDA, within sixty (60) days prior to importation into the State of Nebraska provided that all such imported cattle have had no sexual contact with female cattle since the negative test.
