Anyone who wishes to import non-indigenous cervids into the state of Nebraska or move non-indigenous cervids from one facility to another within Nebraska must sign the statement at the bottom of this form and accurately complete all attached forms and submit them back to the Bureau of Animal Industry office before they will be issued an Entry Permit to bring non-indigenous cervids into the state of Nebraska. Non-indigenous cervids include, but are not limited to, reindeer, caribou, sika deer, fallow deer, Péré David's deer, and moose
