

20th Annual Nebraska Department of Agriculture Poster Contest

Theme: “Celebrating Nebraska Agriculture”

Eligibility

- The poster contest is open to all Nebraska students (public, private, and home school) in **first** through **sixth** grades.
- All artwork must be exclusively student created.
- Each submission must include a completed entry form attached on the back.
- **All entries become the property of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture and will not be returned.**

Criteria

- Each drawing should demonstrate the contest theme.
- Each drawing should be in color, using a medium of your choice (paint, colored pencil, crayon, etc).
- Each entry should be drawn on white paper, measuring 8.5” x 11”.
- **Entries will NOT be accepted if they are folded, rolled up, or are larger than 8.5" x 11”.**

Deadline

- March 1, 2023, is the deadline for entries to be **received** in the Lincoln office. Mail to:

Awards

- Entries will be divided into three age groups for judging purposes:
 - First and second grade;
 - Third and fourth grade; and
 - Fifth and sixth grade.
- Winners will be notified during National Agriculture Week (March 19-25).
- Winning posters will be featured in various NDA publications, special events and on our website.
