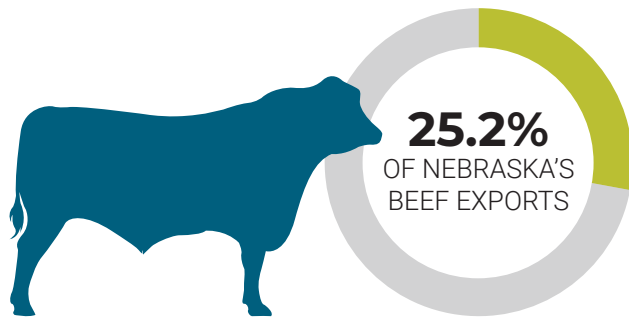
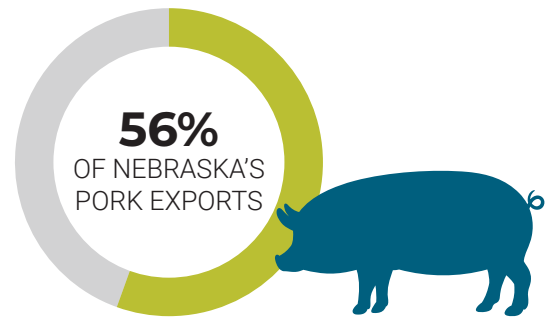


**JAPAN – NEBRASKA’S #1 MARKET FOR BEEF AND PORK**

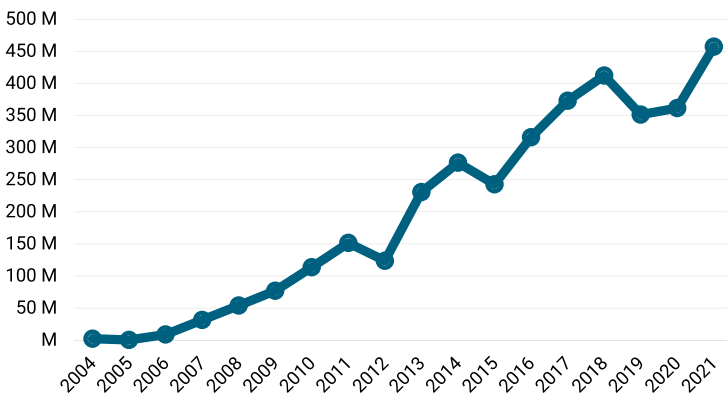
