

## How to obtain Official EID Tags

As part of the USDA 2024 Final Animal Disease Traceability Rule, all official identification tags need to be both visually and electronically readable. This rule only applies to Cattle and Bison 18 months of age and older, sexually intact, and crossing state lines or needing official ID for program disease work. Follow the steps below to obtain EID tags, as well as more information for approved tag manufacturers.
