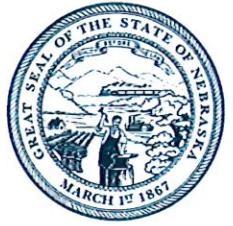

## NEW WORLD SCREWWORM (NWS) NEBRASKA STATE IMPORTATION ORDER

TO ALL AFFECTED PERSONS:

You are hereby notified that the Nebraska Department of Agriculture (Department) is establishing a State Importation Order to enforce the provisions of the United States Department of Agriculture's April 2026 New World Screwworm National Continuity of Business Standardized Animal Movement Guidance (NWS Movement Guidance) which is adopted and made a part of this Order. <https://www.aphis.usda.gov/sites/default/files/nws-national-cob-movement-requirements.pdf>

All animals originating from a NWS Infested Zone and subject to movement requirements under the NWS Movement Guidance are prohibited from being brought into Nebraska except in compliance with its provisions. Companion animals originating from a NWS Infested Zone are also prohibited from entering the state without a premovement inspection documented on an Interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (iCVI) within the same timeframe required by the NWS Movement Guidance for farm-raised animals and captured/captive wild or feral animals. This Order is pursuant to the Animal Health and Disease Control Act (Act), Neb. Rev. Stat. §§54-2901 to 2957. Section 54-2939 of the Act states that it is the policy of this state that animal health and disease control are essential to the livestock industry and the health of the economy of Nebraska. The purpose of the Act is to further the best interests of Nebraska's livestock industry and to grow Nebraska agriculture. Section 54-2940 provides that in carrying out its duties to prevent, suppress, control, and eradicate dangerous diseases the Department has the authority to regulate or prohibit animal or regulated article movement into, within, or through the state through importation orders deemed necessary by the State Veterinarian.

This Order is effective until canceled by the Department.
