

- For up-to-date travel information, visit the **Nebraska Department of Transportation's Nebraska Traveler System**, [www.511.nebraska.gov](http://www.511.nebraska.gov).
  - **Truck Permits:** If you have an oversized load on the interstate, call 402-471-0034 or email [ntpspermits@nebraska.gov](mailto:ntpspermits@nebraska.gov). NDOT will issue a permit for free. There is no central hub of waived weight restrictions by State. Call either the State DOT's or carrier enforcement (varies by state, may be with the DOT or state law enforcement).
  - **Bridge Weight Restriction Map:** This map shows the weight restriction on ALL bridges. Be cautious of county roads – 511 does not show the county.
- Carcass disposal questions should be directed to **Nebraska Department of Water, Energy, and Environment** at 877-253-2603.
