

**NOTICE OF RULEMAKING HEARING
STATE OF NEBRASKA
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nebraska Department of Agriculture (NDA) will hold a rulemaking hearing on June 18, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. CT, LL Hearing Room, 245 Fallbrook Blvd, Lincoln, Nebraska 68521, for the proposed adoption of Nebraska Administrative Code, Title 19, Chapter 5 entitled Adulterated Food Product Regulations. The regulation implements the Nebraska Pure Food Act by establishing standards for determining when food is adulterated with unsafe substances and when such food is misbranded. The proposed regulations provide that food products are adulterated and misbranded if they contain, or are labeled to contain, Tetrahydrocannabinols, Psilocybin (psilocin) or other controlled substances. Marketed and sold as gummies, drops, and a variety of drinks, these synthetic THC products are chemically altered to produce psychoactive qualities similar to Delta-9 THC.

The hearing will be conducted under Neb. Rev. Stat. §84-907. COPIES OF THE PROPOSED ADOPTION AND INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE GOVERNOR INCLUDING THE FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT ARE AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION at NDA or on the website at <https://nda.nebraska.gov/>.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS are invited to attend and testify at the hearing. Reasonable accommodations including the appointment of a licensed interpreter will be provided if requested with seven days notice to NDA at (402) 471-2341 (Voice) or the Nebraska Relay System at 711 or 800-833-7352 (TTY) to ask the operator to call NDA.
