Eligibility

- The poster contest is open to all Nebraska students (public, private, and home school) in first through sixth grades.
- All artworks must be exclusively student created.
- Each submission must include a completed entry form attached on the back.
- All entries become the property of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture and will not be returned.

Criteria

- Each drawing should demonstrate the contest theme.
- Each drawing should be in color, using a medium of your choice (paint, colored pencil, crayon, etc).
- Each entry should be drawn on white paper, measuring 8.5" x 11".
- Entries will NOT be accepted if they are folded, rolled up, or are larger than 8.5" x 11".

Deadline

- March 2, 2026, is the deadline for entries to be received in the Lincoln office. Mail to:

- Entries will be divided into three age groups for judging purposes:
 - First and second grade;
 - Third and fourth grade; and
 - Fifth and sixth grade.
