




VET-CVI

VET-CVI app allows veterinarians to create a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) for small and large animal that are being moved from state-to-state or within state for fairs, rodeos and other local events.

Directions to download the VET-CVI program.

1. Visit your device's store for apps.

- a. If you are searching on an Android device, visit Google Play to search for "VET-CVI" and install the app.
- b. If you are searching on an Apple device, visit the App Store to search for "VET-CVI" and install the app.
- c. If you are searching on your computer (desktop or laptop), [click here](#) or
- d. Click the Windows icon on the bottom of your screen.  Select Microsoft Store in the app list. Once the Microsoft Store window appears, type "VET-CVI". Select the VET-CVI app that displays and follow the installation instructions.



2. Once downloaded, open the VET-CVI app to register an account.

- a. Click Create Account. Fill in all applicable details. Once complete, click Submit at the bottom of the window.
- c. After clicking submit, watch your inbox or junk mail for a confirmation email stating that state animal health officials will be verifying credentials before processing your application within 2 business days.
